## **UPDATED EAC TIME BOUND PROGRAMME ON ELIMINATION OF NON-TARIFF BARRIERS AS PER DECEMBER, 2014**

The meeting of 16<sup>th</sup> EAC Regional on NTBs was held on 9<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 Kigali, Rwanda among other updated EAC Time Bound Programme on elimination of identified NTBs.

**The updated EAC Time Bound Programme shows that:**

- (i) Twenty NTBs were reported as unresolved;**
- (ii) Four new NTBs were reported as new; and**
- (iii) Seventy One NTBs were reported as resolved cumulatively.**
